

'FUTURE VISION PLAN' by PP Mimi



PP Mercia Inkiriwang (Mimi) from the RC of Bali Nusa Dua visited our club to tell us some very interesting information about **The Rotary Foundation's (TRF)** new strategic program called **Future Vision Plan (FVP)**.

She explained that the FVP was intended to replace the current '**Matching Grant**' program that Rotary has been using for many years.

The new Plan will only offer TWO types of Grants:

District Grants

- Simple, flexible, innovative
- Educational and humanitarian projects / activities consistent with mission
- Smaller activities and projects
- Local decision making with broader guidelines
- Amounts to be available - US\$ 0 – US\$ 29,999

Global Grants

- Long-term projects / activities achieving specific qualitative standards
- Rotarian participation
- Larger grant awards
- Sustainable outcomes
- Educational and humanitarian related
- International partnerships required
- Amounts to be available - US\$ 30,000 – US\$ 200,000



PP Mimi then gave the members some **EXAMPLES** of these Grants:

District Grants

- Exchange of mixed profession vocational training teams with another district
- International travel for local doctor to volunteer at a clinic
- Scholarship for student to attend local university for one semester
- Donation of art supplies to assist local youth after-school program
- *Shelterbox* containers sent in response to natural disaster in another district

Global Grants

- International safe drinking water, sanitation, and hygiene education project
- Sponsorship of *Rotary Scholar* to study abroad in a water environmental engineering master's degree program
- International malaria project to distribute bed nets and malaria treatment in conjunction with area hospital
- *Rotary GSE Team* sent abroad to participate in 8-week workshop to learn teaching methods to address adult illiteracy

'CREATE YOUR OWN JEWELRY' by Steffen Schleicher



Last week's Guest Speaker was **Mr. Steffen Schleicher** from Bad Vilbel, Germany who is the owner of PASADA which specializes in clients 'creating' their own JEWELRY.

Steffen started his talk by saying that he really enjoys making LADIES happy. Of course this immediately got the attention of 50% of the membership

About six years ago, Steffen started to think about how he could help people express their individuality.

He then explained that some do it with fashion while others do it with jewelry. However, he discovered that when it came to jewelry, many ladies are difficult to please. Either they don't like the length of their necklaces or the selection of stones. Some don't like the combination of colors or simply they have very unique idea about jewelry design. Lastly, some complain about high prices when they go along with their jeweler to create personal jewelry.

After much thought – his idea was born – 'show people how to create their own jewelry.' What Steffen didn't want to do was use was cheap, plastic pearls and white metal beads from the beading stores. In his collection, he only uses semi-precious stones and real gemstones mixed together with sterling silver and gold.

After a year of analyzing and testing various ideas - PASADA Jewelry Course was born. For this concept to work - everything had to be very simple and easy to use. Everyone needed to be able to understand the system and start creating their own jewelry just after 10 minutes of basic instructions.

Steffen then went on to say, "When clients join a course, they receive a brief introduction about the collection, materials and tools they will need to use. After about 30 minutes, a client starts to create something unique and meaningful. If they only create one beautiful necklace during the time they are with us, they go away very satisfied with their accomplishment."

Since Steffen is only working with real gemstones, he believes only a certain kind of energy is released from these precious stones. When a client sees the stones in the specially prepared boxes, they soon start to imagine what they can create by themselves.



Surprisingly, the positive vibes and energy generated from his stones have enabled him to work very successful in a number of Rehabilitation Clinics in Germany. Remarkably, during the past five years while he has been working in the Clinics, he has seen for himself patients forgetting about their illness and pain and really enjoying a very different, creative experience.

Steffen finished his talk by saying that he hopes in the near future to relocate his family to Bali and start offering his courses to clients in 4-5 star hotels.
