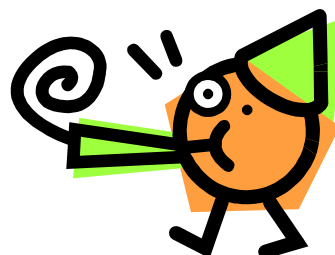

SMILE FOUNDATION by Mary Northmore



Rtn. **Virginie** introduced the Club's Guest Speaker, **Mary Northmore**, the Founder and Director of the **SMILE Foundation**.

Before beginning her quarterly UPDATE regarding the Cleft Lip/Palate operations the SMILE Foundation has completed recently, she asked **Tanya Latussek**, (right) to come up and receive a **Certificate of Appreciation** and a **Smile T-shirt** for **Rtn. Detlev** for his efforts in raising **Rp. 100 million** for the SMILE Foundation. This unbelievable effort will have such a positive affect on so many lives.

Mary then told the members that their April – June report regarding the number of patients who have been treated, will be sent to the Club shortly. This comprehensive report includes the names of the patients, the cost per operation, and before and after photos.

She went on to explain that there are many Indonesians living in the provinces of **NTB** and **NTT** who desperately need the help of the SMILE Foundation. Not many of us understand that the **Sanglah Public Hospital** is the only large full-service hospital that serves these areas. She made this point, because she is hoping that the RCBS will support her in helping individuals who live in these very poor areas of Indonesia.

Mary then turned her attention to Bali's new Free Health Care Program (**BALI MANDARA**) that began officially on 1 January 2010. She very **HAPPILY** reported that the **SYSTEM** is really working – as planed. And to prove her point, she gave the members an example of a young child who recently had a Hospital Bill of over **Rp. 12 million** – but when the parents were checking out – they were only presented with a bill of **Rp. 140,000. MEGA WOW !!!!**

Mary said this program is a **HUGH** step in the right direction and **Bali's Governor, I Made Mangku Pastika** should be congratulated for this wonderful initiative.



PN Patrick then took a minute and personally thanked the SMILE Foundation and Mary for dramatically changing the life of one of his staff – **I Kadek Mayura** (left) - who recently had reconstructive surgery on his nose. Mayura now has a new sense of confidence.
