

# Ensuring the Sustainability of Care Support Treatment (CST) by Emily Rowe and Dinar Lubis



Guest Speakers **Emily Rowe** and **Dinar Lubis** (R) from the **Yayasan Kerti Praja (YKP)** paid a visit to the RCBS to explain how the YKP Care Support Treatment (CST) programs provide for families affected by HIV-AIDS.



They told the members that the YKP was established in 1992 by Prof. Dr. Wirawan, MPH and has mainly focused on the following areas:

1. Detect early HIV-AIDS symptoms and provide treatment promptly.
2. Promote HIV and STI prevention among sex workers, clients of sex workers, gay and transgender through outreach activities by educating them about condom use, etc.
3. Care and Support (CST) for People Living with Aids (PLWHA) by referring victims to doctors and available programs, affordable clinics, CD4 test "buddy" system.
4. Provide affordable HIV and STI clinics.

**Emily** and **Dinar** then gave the members some eye-opening statistics:

1. The cumulative number of AIDS cases in Indonesia over the past 10 years is 20,564 (March 2010). There were 826 reported cases in 2001.
2. 48.7% of the AIDS cases in Indonesia are in the 20-29 year old age group.

Projection of pregnant women in Bali in one year = 1.6% from a total population of 3.5 million. or 56,000 women. And of these women screened, 1/2 % were identified as HIV positive (673). The number of babies infected by HIV from their mothers is 30-50% or 380 babies annually. In the next five years nearly all of them will die.

The CST programs that are already operating by YKP for HIV-AIDS affected children and their families include: medical fee support, hospital assistance for under-privileged families, training for midwives, scholarships, nutritional support, purchasing of bicycles, amongst others.

YKP is seeking funds from RCBS to continue carrying out their programs, e. g.

- Nutrition – SGM/Dancow Powdered Milk.  
27 children x 10 months @ Rp. 150,000 = Rp. 45 million
- Health Services – Medical Care support.  
10 children ONE time x 10 months x Rp. 200,000 = Rp. 20 million
- Education – Elem. School scholarships.  
11 children x 10 months x Rp. 250,000 = Rp. 27.5 million
- administration - Sustainability activities.  
15 children x Rp.150,000 = Rp. 2.25 million
