

Clubfoot Treatment for four-year old Sintia Lestari

Guest Speaker **Dr. Peter Norton** (below center) Podiatrist (Ass. Dip Pod. NSW 1977), graduated from the school of Biological Sciences and the Wallaceworth School of Anatomy at NSW Univ. Australia.

During his 30 years of clinical experience, he has consulted to Rheumatology Dept. of St. Vincent's Priv. Hosp., provided expert opinion for NSW Police and NSW State Coroner's Office and been involved in podiatric consults in Malaysia, UAE, Saudi Arabia and Bahrain. His patients have included 3 ex-PM's of Australia, several Royal Families through Asia and the Middle East.

His wife, Julie (second from left), expressed a heartfelt thanks to **President Robert** (second from right) & **IPP Patricia** (left) and **Tania Ionker** (far right) and the **RCBS** for their generosity in helping little four year-old Sintia Lestari (below). Sintia's mother (below) and father wanted the RCBS to know how very grateful they are for the help their daughter is receiving and beginning to enjoy a normal 'walking' life.



Dr. Norton started his talk by explaining to the Club that a clubfoot is a congenital deformity. At 16 weeks gestation (pregnancy), it can be determined whether there are issues with the feet and this can be detected by ultrasound. At birth the foot is cast into the correct position and any deformity can be easily avoided. In Indonesia it is often not recognized and if recognized there really isn't anybody available to do the treatment and therefore the window of opportunity is missed.

The manipulative technique was pioneered by Dr. Ignacio V. Ponseti, in 1948 who devised this 'unravelling' of the foot by untwisting it through a series of stages during which the foot was placed in casts. The Ponseti method for treating clubfoot, involves the careful manipulation of muscles, joints and ligaments held in a series of casts and braces to reposition the foot back to normal. It became the "gold standard" for clubfoot treatment, after decades of positive follow-up results and numerous international peer-reviewed studies showing success rates as high as 98 percent.

Over the past decade, through educational and advocacy efforts, the Ponseti method has become the mainstream treatment for clubfoot in North America and is increasingly used to help children with clubfoot from underdeveloped regions of the world. In August 2006, the American Academy of Pediatrics endorsed the Ponseti method.

This method is not difficult to teach however a thorough knowledge of anatomy is required. In Sintia's case, when she was first "discovered" in March 2010 by Tania Ionker, Sintia walked on the side of her foot. Today with the help of her brace (which she only wears at night) she walks in a normal manner and no longer suffers this terrible deformity.



The cause for children being born with clubfoot is unknown, however ONE in 1,000 births in Caucasian families and one in 750 births in Asian families still occur today.
