This 12-page tabloid was considered the best way to distribute an essay written by Rotary founder Paul Harris. (The photo on the right was used in that first issue) The essay was titled, "Rational Rotarianism." There was also club news and advertisements. About 2,000 copies were produced by printer [Harry Ruggles](#), one of the first members of the Rotary Club of Chicago. Soon the issue went back to press for another 2,000 copies.



The second issue appeared in July 1911. It contained a "President's Corner," news from the clubs, and more than 20 advertisements. Soon after, the magazine started its monthly publication schedule. (In February 1995, the magazine published its 1,000th issue.) In 1912, by action of the R.I. Convention, the name of the magazine was changed to The Rotarian.

The Rotarian digital edition is coming in July and will be posted on the RI Website every month thereafter.

## **“Revolution from Within”**

Special Guest Speaker, **Rtn. Richard Hazelwood** (below) from the **RC of Crawley, WA, Australia**, is originally from the UK and has been involved in 'Service Clubs' from his 20's, e.g. Round Table, Apex and Rotary.

Two years ago, the membership of the **RC of Matilda Bay** started to decline and they realized that if things did not change, the club would disintegrate. However, the more senior members of the club did not wish change and therefore there was conflict within the club. As a result of this '**Revolution from Within**,' Richard and six others, more forward thinking members, chartered the RC of Crawley.



The Club was chartered in Feb. 2010 with 71 members and it meets for 7:00 a.m. breakfast on the University Campus. With this early starting-time, it enables young professionals and students to go on to their respected jobs and studies after the Meeting. The Club demographic break down, is an almost equal division between Baby Boomers, Gen X and Gen Y.

Changes that have occurred in the NEW Club:

- De-emphasis on 100% attendance. Now only 50% required. (They regularly have 62 members out of 110 at each meeting.)
- Once a month, Verbal reports instead of written ones are given to the membership.
- Focus on Business networking.
- 1st Club in the world to have Corporate Memberships, which sponsor up to 10-12 young people for scholarships. In return, the recipients have to commit to attending Rotary meetings, playing an active role and working with a mentor.
- Half their membership is under 40 years of age!

The joining fee is **AU\$300** which is steep for some potential younger members. The Club subsidizes a number of young Rotarians through their successful fundraising events and they have managed to accumulate significant reserves.

Through forward thinking, planning and working together in a positive enthusiastic atmosphere the club has set the stage for the future of Rotary.
