While PE Patrick was at the BBB, he had an opportunity to talk **Dr. Sudewa, the Director of the BBB**, about the chronic shortage of ALL types of Rh Neg Blood types. Dr. Sudewa asked if the Rotary Clubs in Bali could help the BBB with this ongoing problem. It was decided that the BBB would organize a meeting in June to discuss some strategies on how to resolve this life-threatening problem.
